



Inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) refers to a group of disorders that cause long-term inflammation in the gut wall and persistent or recurrent gastrointestinal (GI) signs. IBD is a commonly diagnosed cause of chronic vomiting and diarrhoea in dogs and cats and may be associated with a range of other symptoms.

There is no one single test or treatment to confirm or manage IBD. Here at VSS we take a systematic approach to help us investigate factors that may be contributing to chronic GI signs in the least invasive ways possible. Investigations may include blood tests, treatment trials with diet changes or medication, progressing to biopsies of the gut wall as needed.

We are pleased to be able to offer endoscopic biopsies to further investigate chronic vomiting and diarrhoea as indicated.
