


Advanced Diagnostic Imaging at VSS



Veterinary Specialist Services is home to some of the most sophisticated diagnostic imaging modalities in veterinary medicine.

The diagnostic imaging suites include diagnostic ultrasound, digital radiography, fluoroscopy, CT Scan (Carrara, Jindalee and Underwood) and MRI (Underwood).

CT and MRI are advanced imaging techniques that allow veterinarians to see more detailed images of the internal structures of a pet's body. These scans can help diagnose a variety of conditions, including cancer, neurological disorders, and bone fractures.

CT scans use X-rays and computer technology to create detailed images of the body's structures, while MRI scans use powerful magnets and radio waves to create detailed images of soft tissues like the brain, spinal cord, and joints. Your VSS Veterinarian will advise you of the most appropriate imaging modality to choose.

These non-invasive scans can help us identify underlying health issues and develop a individualised treatment plan.
